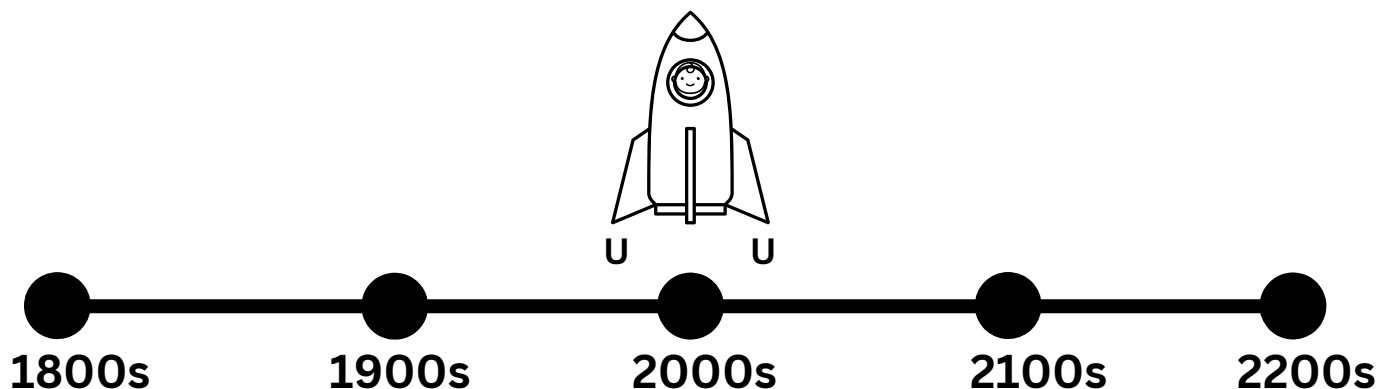


THE LANDING OF "U" FACTS

5. What is one statement that U can remember that best describes yoUr primary caretaker's philosophy of life?

a. Is there a word or phrase that was a favorite of yoUr primary caretaker(s)?

b. Is there an activity or experience that U enjoyed participating in with yoUr primary caretakers or siblings?

6. What one geological/natural feature stands out in yoUr memory from the place U were born?

7. What one human-made feature stands out in yoUr memory from the place U were born?

8. *What one advertisement stands out in yoUr very early memories?*

9. *Do U identify yoUrself more as a member of a nationality, a member of a country, a member of a state, a member of a particular faith or something else (or nothing at all)*

10. *What was yoUr favorite childhood toy?*

11. Did you have any favorite creatures? (animals, insects, reptiles, sea creatures)

a. Were there particular creatures indigenous to the place you were born or lived as a child?

b. Did you have pets? What color were they? Any patterns?

c. Do you have a special affection for any type of creatures at this present time?

12. What was your favorite color as a child?
